Tom Miller

Tom Miller graduated from the University of Massachusetts at Lowell and then received a Master's degree in Medical Physics from Harvard University/MIT Health Sciences and Technology Program. Tom Miller then joined **Siemens Medical Systems**, where he became the first non-German CEO of a German factory and business unit. After 15 years, he left Siemens to take over the management of medical business of **Carl Zeiss**. After completing a successful turnaround, he joined **Analogic Corporation** as CEO. Tom Miller left the company to help establish and become CEO of **LightLab Imaging**, a leader in the field of cardiovascular optical coherence tomography. Subsequently, after a profitable sale of LightLab to a Japanese company, Tom Miller returned to Siemens, where he became a member of the operating board and CEO of Customer Solutions Division of **Siemens Healthcare**.

Tom Miller is a frequent speaker on healthcare technology and business at such venues as the National Press Club, the National Library of Medicine, the National Institute of Health, and the American Hospital Association. Sponsored by the American Hospital Association, Tom gave the **keynote speech on Sustainable Healthcare and Precision Medicine** at the Health Executive Forum in Arizona in 2013.

In 2013 Tom Miller founded **GreyBird Ventures**, **LLC** which is the world's first venture firm focused exclusively on solving the most critical diagnostic problems to accelerate the trend toward precision medicine.
